What has been happening in the village?

- 1) We have a 20mph speed limit at last
The Police Motorcycle Speed-check has been visiting
The Parish Council is replacing the traffic speed indicator coming from Frome
The council will place a second speed-indicating device for Radstock traffic
We have a very active Village Community Speed Watch and will hear about it
- 2) A Parish Council £16,300 grant from Somerset County Council has provided solar panels with batteries to the Village Hall saving hundreds of pounds yearly
- 3) We will hear about all the Village Hall activities
- 4) We will hear about Parish Council plans
- 5) We are to have splendid Platinum Jubilee weekend activities with a report from your community group who are arranging

The parish council was able to get a grant towards costs for this

Saturday 4th will have a Village Hall party lunch for villagers – come and hear more

The Playing Field will be active on Friday and Saturday the 3rd and 4th
