species of snowdrops, funded by the grant she obtained which was mentioned earlier. These are apparently clearly labelled and our thanks must go to Ellie and her team of volunteer clearers and planters.

This year I have had the great joy of seeing all my accumulated hellebores flowering for the first time. Each year I buy one or two more but in spite of a firm "talking to" in recent springs I have seen only the odd flower. This year, I was prepared to give the usual admonitory "pep talk" but - BINGO! A mass of huge flowers, pink, dark purple, spotted, cream and pure white. What a welcome home and boost to recovery! Also the tiny jewel bright cyclamen coum are illuminating the ground beneath the old apple tree. And the first of the camellias are in full flowers – Martin Cachet, the double red February bloomer, and Mary Christian, the huge single pink, whose pendulous branches hung with their pale lanterns of blossom, weave under and over the adjoining apple tree and the magnolia.

I was talking to a friend the other day who said that whenever she used one of her one of her old family sayings or quoted some bit of weather related folklore her grandchildren fell about laughing and asked wherever she had "got that from". We started comparing family sayings – so familiar because we grew up hearing them from our own grandparents. They are regional, too, as one finds if moving from one county to another. When she was tired of answering my childhood questions, my Kentish grandmother used to say, "you want to know the ins and outs of a magpie's behind." Local Somerset sayings, now familiar after 50 plus years here, like "the weather looks brighter over Bill's mother's" or the universal, with local variations, "enough blue sky to make a sailor a pair of trousers". Local names, too, like "Peggy-dish-washer" for

If I were younger, I would think of compiling a book of them but I lack the energy or research facilities now. Maybe someone might? Or even has done already? Enjoy the spring! ### MATTERS ARISING

**Barn and paddock lease:** The paddock lease has been signed and is ready for submission to Land Registry which the Clerk will action. The Barn lease is continuing on a rolling basis.

**Quarry noise:** A meeting has been arranged with the Quarry Manager on February 28th. **Bus shelter graffiti – Vobster:** Cllr Brady has quoted £110 to remove the graffiti and paint the whole shelter with masonry paint. Work to be carried out when the weather is better.



### HIGHWAY AND FOOTPATH ISSUES:

**Grass triangle – Bottom Lane:** The memorial tree will be planted week commencing February 17th. Topsoil to level the area should be in place by the end of March.

**Area in front of Vobster Inn:** A small old truck on rails has been sourced which requires the approval of the inn owners before installation.

**Speeding vehicles in Vobster**: No response from Highways. Clerk to chase.

**Damaged bridge – Vobster Cross**: Works on the bridge have begun and will last approximately three weeks. Cllr Brady will speak to the Works Manager to see if a no through road sign can be placed on the junction to stop drivers continuing straight across and having to turn around.

**Speeding traffic and mud on road - Lime Kiln Hill:** The mud situation has improved significantly and the sweeper is out frequently. Cllr Brady has received a letter from the local MP who acknowledges there is a speeding problem around the parish and will contact the Police and respond back in due course.

**Erosion of verge:** Owner has assured that this will be re-instated and commented that this was due to the works taking longer than expected and the recent weather conditions.

**Water seeping through tarmac – Little Green:** Clerk to report that water is continuing to bubble through the tarmac. The source is assumed to be a spring. The




